
You may be aware of the new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) regarding privacy which comes into force on 25th May 2018.


Under the new arrangements you will have the ability to tell our coaching team how you want us to handle your personal data.

In order to do this we have added four consent (only two will actually apply to you: Emails and Photography) boxes to your Profile in ClubSpark. To access these you need to do the following:-

1. For an individual membership - the user will click on their name in the top right corner after signing in - and select 'profile' - see narrow arrow below:



2. Click on the 'edit profile' button to the right of the name in large font (see large arrow above) and the following screen will display:



- 3. Click the middle box Your Privacy and Consents (see above arrow).
- 4. Click the boxes to place ticks against the Consents you wish to approve (the consents noted above are for demonstration purposes only).

You may change your mind to these consents at any time by returning to Your Profile and amending your consents.
