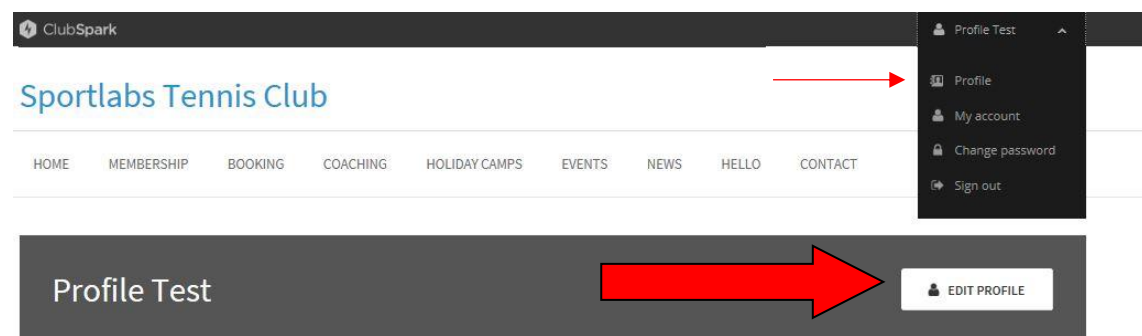


You may be aware of the new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) regarding privacy which comes into force on 25th May 2018.

Under the new legislation members have greater control over the use of their personal information and are able to tell the club how they want their personal data to be used.

In order to comply with GDPR the Club has amended/added consents to Your Profile in ClubSpark. To give consent to these please do the following:-

1. For an individual membership - the user will click on their name in the top right corner after signing in - and select 'profile' - see narrow arrow below:

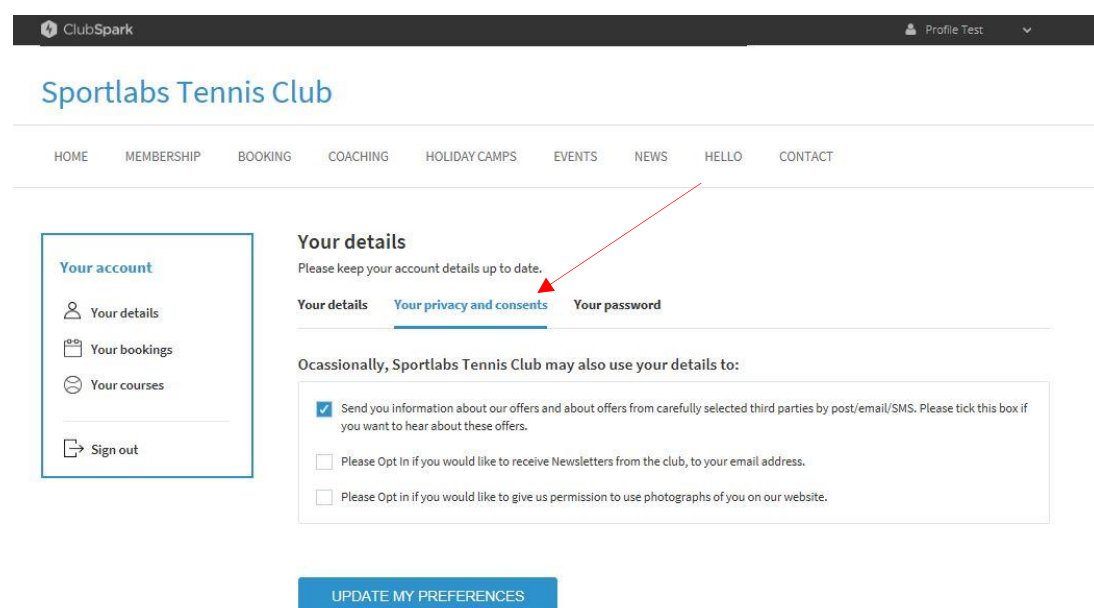


Court bookings

2. Click on the 'edit profile' button to the right of the name in large font (see large arrow above) and the following screen will display:



3. Click the middle box Your Privacy and Consents (see above arrow).
4. Click the boxes to place ticks against the Consents you wish to approve (the consents noted above are for demonstration purposes only).

You may change your mind to these consents at any time by returning to Your Profile and amending your consents.
